CURRENT CONDITIONS AND AMENITIES

- 0.4 acres considered a "pocket park"
- Amenities include benches, 2 chess/checkers tables, bike rack
- 1 trash can and dog waste station
- Landscaping includes trees, plants, grass, and hardscaping
- Space is limited: several underground stormwater and sewer lines
- Excessive dog waste is an issue










SPRING 2024 SITE CONDITIONS

Planned Maintenance Activities

- 1) Mulching, weeding, spring clean up^
- 2) Mowing to begin soon (2x / month)^
- 3) Install 1 more tree (6 trees planted in December 2023). New trees were installed to replace trees that did not survive initial transplanting. They should provide shade, but it will take time.
- 4) Remove boulders to increase useable space and make mowing easier




Opportunities to Explore Further

- Install 2 picnic tables

 But they can be matched to concrete pads on other side of lawn. Possibly add shade structures over tables.
- Shade structure on west side of park along 8th St.
- Install additional trash can and dog waste bags.



Dog Feces and the Environment


We are going to work closely with the Office of Sustainability, Water Resource Specialist and Animal control officer to create a plan to help promote dog feces removal in our city parks and on trails.
